



First Quarter Vocabulary Menu

***Complete 3 activities each week with your weekly vocabulary words. By the end of the quarter, you must have done each activity at least twice.**

<p><i>Illustrator</i> Draw a <u>detailed picture</u> that represents the meaning of each word. Explain your picture in a few sentences directly below it. Include the vocabulary word in each sentence. *Stick figures or a simple sketch are not acceptable.</p>	<p><i>Word Trees</i> Write the prefix, suffix, or root words we are studying. Write their meanings directly below. Then, make a list of a least 6 new words with the same prefix, suffix, or root word. Make sure you highlight or underline all of your words. <i>Go above and beyond and include some other words with prefix, suffix, or root word we are studying!</i></p>	<p><i>Vocabulary Rap</i> Write a vocabulary rap using your vocabulary words.
